You may define some flags to be passed to tasks at compile time. They will be added to compile line as <code>-DKEY=value</code> on every source file for a given task

Usage examples

Yes, have double quotes for strings so that the name is still a string when it comes to C...

Warning

Defined values when compiling a C file are unpredictable if

- This C file is shared between tasks
- The task corresponding to the C-file is **instanciated more than once** with **different** defines

If the only purpose is to pass up a numeric value, you should use consts.
